Dear Sir

With regards my child Wilhelmina. She used to be at Brockhall and when there we had regular correspondence till she was transferred on the 20th December, 1921, to Calderstones Institution, moreover we sent the child an Exmas parcel and does not know whether she received same or not, till my wife went to-day and enquired about her, and finds out after she went to the Education Offices, Deansgate, Manchester, and that they know nothing about the child and referred us to you, so we are wondering where the child is now, and don't you think we would do after what we were told the child was going to Calderstones for her schooling so think its high time we know where are child was, moreover it is our duty to know as parents. I should be greatly obliged to if you could furnish us with her whereabouts as we have sent two letters this month and stamped addressed envelopes and no response, so do you think that is fair treatment to any parents, she is our child and we don't think any the less for her being away. We were told by Mrs. Fullaway, the Lady Visitor, that she would inform us about her welfare and I never received one line since she went in that direction, so you can see the plight we are in as regards to the child. It is with words that that I close and hope to hear from you at the earliest opportunity.
